

Si porta a conoscenza dei nostri operatori, esportatori di piante e materiali di moltiplicazione, che alcune ditte olandesi richiedono ad operatori italiani dichiarazioni supplementari per *Xylella fastidiosa* ed *Anoplophora chinensis* non conformi alla vigente normativa fitosanitaria, in assenza delle quali dichiarano che non è consentita la vendita di piante nei Paesi Bassi.

Nello specifico viene richiesta la compilazione del modello [Intra-EC Phytosanitary Communication Document](#), che invece va utilizzato per l'esportazione verso Paesi terzi, qualora richiesto, in aggiunta alla certificazione fitosanitaria prevista dal D.Lgs 214/05. Si fa presente che **la compilazione del citato modello per il commercio intracomunitario non è prevista dalla vigente normativa fitosanitaria**, in particolare dalle disposizioni della Decisione 789/2015 su *Xylella fastidiosa*. Pertanto eventuali richieste vanno impedito e non soddisfatte in quanto non conformi alle norme in vigore.
